INDEPENDENT LIVING RESIDENT TESTS POSITIVE FOR COVID-19

Yesterday we learned an IL resident tested positive for COVID-19 after being transported to the hospital for suspected pneumonia. At this time, the point of exposure has not been determined. Contact tracing is underway. This resident case is unrelated to the staff case that was reported on 7/13.

While we do not typically reveal the vaccination status of individuals, we feel it is important to share that this resident was fully vaccinated and therefore this is considered a breakthrough case. As experts continue to research how common breakthrough cases are as well as the effectiveness of the vaccine against variants, it is important to continue to take precautions to protect yourself and others.
