

Visitation Protocols The Springvale Inn

BSI published visiting hours are from 10am to 6 pm; however those residents wishing visitation at an alternate time/ or family wishing an alternate time will be accommodated as long as it does not impose on the rights/well-being of other residents. There will no longer be a limit on the number of visitors a resident may have at one time; or the number of residents who may have visitors at one time except that facilities must ensure that there is space for physical distancing of 6 feet; especially at 'busy' times of visitation.

Outdoor visitation is preferred when the resident/ and or visitor are not fully vaccinated against COVID 19. This poses a lower risk of transmission due to increased space and airflow. However, weather considerations or resident health status may hinder outdoor visitation.

Indoor Visitation will be allowed for all residents/at all times with the above considerations.

All visitors must be screened prior to visitation: They will be screened for temperature >100. F, as well as Covid-19 symptoms, or a positive viral test for COVID-19; and those who meet the criteria for quarantine. They will be asked their vaccination status although this is not a requirement for visitation nor do they have to provide proof. However this will help the facility be able to educate the visitor and the resident about their risk status; as well as the need for source control. If someone does not wish to answer they will be requested to keep a mask on during their visit.
