VISITATION PROTOCOL FACT SHEET

Visiting will begin 7-21-2020

- Limited visitation may change at any time at the discretion of the DOH or the facility
- If staff or resident's test positive; in-person visitation will be suspended for 28 days from the date the positive test was reported on the DOH HERDS survey
- All visitors will be screened for signs and symptoms of COVID-19 prior to resident access and visitation will be refused if the individual(s) exhibit any COVID-19 symptoms; or do not pass the screening questions. Please reschedule your visit if you are not feeling well!
- All visitors will have their temperature taken prior to visitation, if a visitor has a fever ≥ 100.0 F then they will not be allowed to visit
- Visitors must complete the documentation screening before the visit can occur; including contact information
- Visitation will be held Monday – Friday and weekends at the discretion of the recreation department's availability. Hours of visitation are 10am, 11am, 2pm and 4pm, for ½ hour intervals beginning at the top of the hour
- The visitation area will be cleaned and disinfected after each visit
- Visitation is limited to the outdoor patio only, weather permitting. In case of inclement weather visit will be rescheduled.
- Appointments must be made with the Recreation Department in advance. Please call 914-941-7300 extension 3277.
- Limited visitation will include family members and health care proxy's as a priority and loved ones secondary
- No more than 10 percent (10%) of the residents shall have visitors at any one time and only two visitors will be allowed per resident at any one time
- Visitors must wear a facemask at all times while on the premises-if you do not have one, a mask will be provided
- As tolerated, the resident must also wear a facemask
- Floor markings and social distancing must be adhered to during visitation
- Hand hygiene must be practiced with alcohol-based hand rub provided
- Visitation is strictly prohibited in resident rooms or care areas
- If a resident is in a 14-day quarantine or observation period, visitation is not permitted
- If any visitor fails to adhere to the protocol, he/she/they will be prohibited from visiting for the duration of the COVID-19 State declared public health emergency.
