

## Independent Living Limited Visitation Protocol

The health and safety of our residents, staff and visitors remain a top priority for Lambeth House. In accordance with the Centers for Disease Control, we have developed a Visitation Policy for visitors of Independent Living. Thank you for your cooperation.

- Visitation is limited to family and close friends and certain people for business purposes (attorney, CPA, etc.). This does **NOT** give visitation privileges to private duty staff such as sitters, housekeepers, or other domestic helpers.
- Visitation is limited to no more than three guests at a time to allow for social distancing.
- All visitation must occur between 7:30am and 8:00 pm.
- Visitors are required to socially distance at all times while on Lambeth House property.
- All visitors must wear masks upon entering the property. Masks must always be worn while on premises, including upon entering the exterior of the building and while inside the apartment you are visiting.
- Masks must be worn **correctly** for maximum protection. Masks must cover your nose and mouth at all times. Masks should never be worn around your neck or on your forehead. Masks with an exhalation valve or vent/port are **NOT** allowed.
- All visitors will be screened for flu-like symptoms such as cough, fever, chills, or shortness of breath. Visitors who are ill or who are exhibiting symptoms consistent with COVID-19, will not be permitted to enter under any circumstance.
- All visitors are required to remain in the apartment of the resident that they have come to visit. Visitors are NOT allowed in common spaces at Lambeth House. Additionally, visitors are not allowed to congregate in any area of the building, including the lobby, while in route to see a Lambeth House resident. No other resident may visit your apartment while you have an outside visitor.
- Upon entering the building, visitors must use the alcohol-based hand sanitizer which is available at the front door or at the front desk.
- After using alcohol-based hand sanitizer, visitors are to proceed to the temperature scan stand to receive a temperature check and complete the screening form to assess for potential signs of illness.
- If screening is successful, visitors may proceed to the elevator and go directly to the apartment you are visiting where they must remain until they are ready to depart the property.
- Upon approaching the elevator lobby, you will again use the alcohol-based hand sanitizer made available before entering the elevator.
- Upon arriving back on the first floor to exit, you will sign out of the visitor log and immediately leave the building. Please do not linger in the lobby to prevent any congestion in the lobby.
- Visitors who have been approved to spend the night with a family member at Lambeth must stay inside the apartment until departure the next day. Overnight visitors may not leave the apartment until they are ready to exit the building. Visitors must also notify the front desk during screening of the planned and actual arrival and departure times. Overnight stays must be preapproved by Jennifer Credeur, Director of Social Services. Overnight stays are limited to only one guest in your apartment.
- **Lambeth House management reserves the right to restrict visitation for violators of this policy.**
