



COVID-19 UPDATE

For Residents, Family Members, and Staff
Wednesday, December 9, 2020

We were notified today that an Independent Living resident has tested positive for COVID-19. This individual was tested on 12/6 and received the results of the test on 12/9. This individual is not experiencing any symptoms and is following quarantine protocols since learning the results of the test.

Due to The Pines' regular surveillance testing, we also learned late yesterday afternoon that a Health Center staff member tested positive for COVID-19. This individual was tested on 12/2 and received test results on 12/8. This person has not experienced any symptoms.

Routine indoor and outdoor visitations in our Schramm Health Center will restart on 12/22 if there are no more positive COVID-19 cases among our Health Center staff or residents before that date.

Please continue to maintain (and even elevate) your personal safety protocols: wear a mask; maintain safe distance from others; wash your hands thoroughly; stay on campus; consider postponing visits with family/friends at The Pines' visitation station. Extra vigilance is needed now, especially since the COVID-19 positivity rate is rising to troubling levels. We are monitoring this situation closely and appreciate your continued engagement in safe practices.
