



COVID-19 UPDATE

Monday, December 21, 2020

We learned today that an Independent Living resident has tested positive for COVID-19. After developing symptoms, this individual was tested on 12/17 and was notified of the results on 12/20. The resident has contacted a physician and is self-quarantining.

Both a non-health center staff member and an Independent Living resident who had previously tested positive for COVID-19 have recovered and completed their quarantine.

While we know that the rise in COVID-19 cases at The Pines and in our region is troubling, please be assured that The Pines is monitoring this situation closely. Please continue to exercise personal safety habits vigilantly – wear masks properly and when interacting with others, wash hands frequently, maintain social distancing (6 feet from others) and keep the interactions brief. Please reconsider traveling off campus unless it is absolutely necessary. We appreciate everyone’s help in keeping our community safe.
